August 13th: Deirdre Kessler, "Sir Andrew Macphail and L.M. Montgomery: The Emotional Textures of the Lives of Two Distinguished Islanders," Deirdre, our Island's current Poet Laureate will provide glimpses into the lives, poetry and the writings of Macphail and Montgomery. THE FIRE PREVENTION ACT states from <u>March 15th to</u> <u>December 1st</u> of any year.... there shall be NO OPEN FIRES (GRASS, BUSH ETC) WITH OUT A PERMIT.

Landowners, contractors, government/private projects are required to have burning permits which are available from the Dept of Energy & Forestry District Office, West Royalty on Beach Grove Road (368-4800). It is IMPERATIVE that the landowner check the fire index via internet, local radio stations. TV and newspapers also report the fire index daily through the summer month. If in doubt, contact the Forestry Dept. FAILURE TO HAVE A VALID BURNING PERMIT CAN RESULT IN A FINE OF \$200.00 OR MORE.


