Farmers Helping Farmers News for Belfast and Beyond

Belfast is such a historical farming community with connections around the world. One modern connection is with Kenya's farming community through links made by Farmers Helping Farmers (FHF). FHF is well known to some in Belfast. The P.E.I.-based organization has been working for over 35 years with farm families, schools and dairies in the Mount Kenya area, about a five hour drive from Nairobi. Islanders have gone to Kenya and Kenyans have visited us in P.E.I. One group visiting the Island from Kenya stopped for a coffee break at Cooper's Red and White in October 2016. They also visited Penny's Strawberry Farm for lunch and to see the crop of soy beans and the mixed farming that Penny's do so well. Now is the annual time to help FHF raise funds through the Holiday Campaign One option is to fund vegetable seeds for a school garden for \$25. We also give gift cards that you can put into a Christmas stocking or Christmas card. A new option is to direct donations to make schools more disability-friendly with ramps, hand rails, and wide doorways You can go online to donate gift cards, or donations in honour or in memory of someone. Big Belfast: A Rural Model Community:

Please, save this date: January 17, 2018 at 7:00 at the Belfast Recreation Centre. The Belfast Historical Society is holding its large Community Meeting to further promote our open process and to gather input and committed support for a community plan. ALL arewelcome!

At the historic heart of our community is the 1803 story of Lord Selkirk who envisioned what a community should look like — and then, he made it happen. He intended that this Belfast settlement would be a model for his future settlements and for the emigration plans of other men of his day.

A plan for a renewed community would be the best legacy we could leave honouring Thomas Douglas, the fifth Earl of Selkirk while at the same time addressing some very real issues in our rural communities (Lots 57, 58, 60 and 62 from Orwell Cove to Little Sands.) We propose the creation of a contemporary *model* for rural and regional community development.

We have letters of support from the Wood Islands and Area Development Corporation; the Belfast Community Development Corporation; MLA Darlene Compton; the Mt. Buchanan/Point Prim Women's Institute; the Belfast Community Council; and more throughout Big Belfast. To assist in finding funds and in-kind support, we hope to get a letter from you, also.
