Ireland Meets Scotland Returns for 2018!

This high-caliber celebration of Celtic heritage, music and dance will be performed at two historic venues for 2018. Tuesday evenings July 10-Aug 28 at Beaconsfield Historic House in Charlottetown, and Friday evenings July 13-Aug 31 at Orwell Corner Historic Village in Orwell. All shows begin at 7:30pm. 15 adults, \$7.50 children under 12.

Ireland Meets Scotland tells the compelling story of Irish and Scottish immigrants leaving their homelands in the 1800s and meeting in the New World, many of them here on Prince Edward Island. The story is told primarily through music and dance, with just enough prose and poetry to set the scenes in the mind's eye of the audience.

The show features Colin and Tristan Jeffrey on fiddle, Amanda Mark on flute & tin whistle, Kevin Jeffrey on guitar & vocals, and Celtic dancers Marlys and Alexis Maclaren and Abigail Rogers. The family aspect of the show is highlighted by father/son musicians Kevin, Colin & Tristan, and mother/ daughter dancers Marlys & Alexis.

The Ireland Meets Scotland show is significant since it celebrates the Scottish and Irish heritage of Prince Edward Island and new immigrants settling on PEI. The 2018 season will also be a reunion of the original cast from the show's critically acclaimed run during 1999-2002.

The nearby Macphail Homestead will be serving suppers featuring fresh local ingredients every Friday evening before the show, starting at 5:00 pm. Visitors can also book a Package Experience consisting of a wagon ride from Orwell Corner Historic Village to Macphail Homestead for supper, and a wagon ride back to Orwell Corner for the Ireland Meets Scotland Show.

August Update! Pinette-Flat River-Roseberry Mosquito Program

The "Mosquito Management Team" has been hard at it, by most accounts it seems to be working. Most people report quite acceptable levels of mosquitoes around their homes, certainly less than before program was started for those that can remember running to our cars. Treatments started in April and have carried on after each high tide since then. To date, most of the treating has been done by the "team" with help from a few stalwart regulars. However, help will be much appreciated with future treatments. Treatment for July has been completed. The next really high tides are scheduled for Aug. 12-14, so we will almost certainly be looking for volunteers then. People sometimes ask if we can give more notice about when help is needed... but, unfortunately, we can't. It is hard to predict exactly when the hatch is going to happen and, now that the water is warmer, we only have a few days to get the treatment done once we find larvae. If you haven't got your financial support for the 2018 program in yet, please do so soon. There is no external funding. We are asking \$120.00 per household. Management has been running well at previous pricing, but even with the reduced use of material, the material has increased in price.
