### May Update! Pinette-Flat River-Roseberry 2019 Mosquito Program

As mentioned in the April notification, Spring brings with it warmth, renewal, and the return of these dreaded pests. We are already scouting, and treatment has begun for the season, with team members being out in all areas. Our goal, as always, is to manage the mosquitos to the best of our ability, so they do not return with a vengeance. I am sure most of us can recall back before the program was started, how bad the infestation was. The mosquitos will return, if we do not stay mission focused in managing them.

There are many species of mosquitos on PEI, and we are only fighting a couple of these species. This is accomplished, with timing being everything, when they are at the larval stage, before moving to pupal stage and on to adult flying pests. As we previously shared with you, there will always be mosquitos, we will never eliminate them all and, before the program started, going outside in the summer was very miserable for most homes in this area. As always and most importantly, we need your continued support as mentioned in the April edition. Management has been running well at present pricing, however, even with the reduced use of material, due to the reduced quantity of larva, the material has increased in price. ### The Belfast Lions Club - What Lions is All About

We support Dog Guides Canada as part of the Lions Foundation of Canada, located in Oakville, Ontario. The program provides trained dogs, to assist Canadians with a medical or physical disability, such as Hearing, Service, Seizure Response, Autism Assistance, Diabetic Alert, and Support dog guides. These Dog Guides, once trained, are provided at no cost to eligible Canadians from coast to coast. To do this, the Foundation operates the Dog Guides Canada, national training school and charity through specialized Dog Guide programs, despite costing \$25,000 to train and place. The Foundation relies on donations from individuals, service clubs, foundations and corporations and does not receive any government funding. There are dogs that have been placed on PEI.

### **Out of Province Medical Travel Support Programs**

You may not know; the Province presently operates four Out of Province Travel Support Programs. The program will provide financial support for eligible patients and/or their essential escorts traveling out of the province. This ensures travel is possible for all PEI residents who hold a valid PEI Health Card. Financial assistance is provided through subsidizing eligible applicants and their essential escorts' fare costs. Health PEI reviews all requests using eligibility criteria, based on total household income:

- 1. *Maritime Bus Program*: subsidizes the cost to Maritime Bus service destinations.
- 2. *Hope Air Flights Program*: a national charity, to provide free commercial flights for eligible PEI residents to travel for medical services out-of-province, outside of the Maritimes.
- 3. Hope Air Bridge Toll Program: subsidizes the cost of, Bridge Toll passes for eligible PEI residents to travel for medical services out-of-province using a private vehicle.
- Hope Air Ferry Pass Program: subsidizes the cost of Northumberland Ferries Limited passes for eligible PEI residents to travel for medical services out-of-province using a private vehicle.




