With spring comes hope and rebirth. Unfortunately, this includes a baby boom of mosquito larvae. The good news is that your licensed volunteers in Pinette and Flat River have been diligent with monitoring and treating as spring advances and the warmer weather brings ideal breeding conditions. The COVID-19 pandemic has required the team to use physical distancing, but this does not affect our operations to any significant degree. As of this writing, all of the usual problematic wetland areas have been monitored and treatment has been initiated or planned in the near future.

Last season we made arrangements for 17 of our volunteers to be licensed. Our team is trained and experienced. None of our volunteers are paid, and spend countless hours working hard to bring the mosquito population to tolerable levels. As always, this season our biggest expense is the cost of Vectobac, the larvicide that we use. To continue our work, we are asking those within our communities to contribute a suggested amount of \$120 per household. 
