- * Immediate electronic public notice of <u>Acclamation</u> will be issued, if only one candidate is nominated for the vacant position of Councillor.
- By-Election Advance Poll (if required) Saturday, March 13th, 2021 (Belfast Firehall)
- By-Election Day (if required) Monday, March 15th, 2021 (Belfast Firehall)
- Councillor Sworn In Wednesday, March 17th, 2021
- First Day of Office for New Councillor Thursday, April 1st, 2021 (term will end on December 6th, 2022)

This unfortunate turn of events has forced us to seek an alternate publisher to provide the 2021 Calendar. We are currently in the process of working with a new supplier to print the 2021 Calendar.

This new partnership will take time to develop and will require a *huge* effort to start over from the beginning. Although the Belfast Lions Club and our new publisher are working exceptionally hard to print and deliver the Calendar as soon as possible, there will be an unavoidable delay in delivery. Everything possible is being done to have the Calendar available by early March. For this reason, the Calendar will cover the 12-month period from April 2021 to March 2022.

We thank you for your patience and continued support of this important annual fundraising effort as we work through the difficulties caused by the bankruptcy and closure of Linmark Publishing Ltd.


