#### Municipality-wide Mosquito/Black Fly Control (Proposal)

The Pinette/Flat River and Point Prim Mosquito Programs have prepared a proposal for consideration by the Belfast Community Council. The proposal suggests that the Municipality replicate the highly successful biting fly control program that has been operating in Eastern Kings for many years. The program would be funded by the Municipality, but operated by the Belfast Community Development Corp. It calls for two seasonal employees to take responsibility for the control of mosquito (both salt- and fresh-water species) and black fly larvae throughout the Municipality. Vectobac, which is a completely environmentally safe product for reducing numbers of mosquito and black fly larvae, would be used. The program will require an approximately 3.5% increase in overall property taxes in the region in order to avoid having any impact on other beneficial activities undertaken by the Council. The proposal includes feedback from local tourism operators and real estate agents as to the impact of mosquitoes on their businesses and land values.

#### Wood Islands Revitalization Plan

# Community Pride. Community Engagement. Community Voice.

The Wood Islands Revitalization Plan is a 100-Day Process intended to enhance local quality of living and bring enhanced destination stature to the Wood Islands area - Lighthouse, Provincial Park, Sustainable Shorelines, Harbour/Port and connected to Wood Islands Village (formerly Plough the Waves) via an extension of the Confederation Trail. Also included is the provision for a replacement 'Fishing Village' - new look, new location.

This is a plan that will celebrate Wood Islands' natural environment, its rich heritage and stories and is intended for the use and enjoyment of Wood Islands and area residents as well as visitors to Prince Edward Island.

The process is under the direction of the Wood Islands & Area Development Corporation (WIADC) and various community stakeholders forming a Project Steering Committee. The consultants working on this assignment are iImagine, based in Charlottetown in partnership with The Glenn Group, based in Fredericton, N.B. Both firms have a lengthy history working to advance tourism and the well-being of communities across the Island, throughout Atlantic Canada and elsewhere in Canada.

During the 100 days, viewpoints and ideas will be sought and considered, with a draft strategy to be presented to the community in an open-house setting on a date to be determined in March 2022, subject to Covid-19 protocols and restrictions.




