Items of note for the *Rural Municipality of Belfast* for the month of *March 2022*:

Council Accepts Mosquito Abatement Proposal to Start in 2022!

On January 18th, 2022, RMB received a Municipal-wide Mosquito Abatement Proposal at a cost of \$60,000 for the 2022/2023 fiscal year and ongoing. A few groups combined their efforts to prepare/present this proposal to Council.

Upon review of the proposal and further discussion/clarification; Council Members, in a majority vote during the public February 16th Council meeting, accepted the proposal. The Municipal-wide Mosquito Abatement Program will start in the spring of 2022. The Mosquito Program is available on the RMB Website.

2022/2023 Community Grants Applications Deadline is March 6th!

RMB will be awarding \$64,000 this fiscal year to worthy organizations striving for the participation and betterment of our Municipality.

Council gives 1st Reading to the RMB 2022/2023 Budget/Financial Plan!

On Feb. 16th, Council gave 1st Reading to the 2022/2023 RMB Budget/Financial Plan during a public meeting of Council. This Budget represents a \$.06/100 increase for this fiscal year. The second and final public meeting for this Plan will take place on March 16th, at 7:00 PM in the Wood Islands Meeting Hall, during the regular meeting of Council. The document is available on the RMB Website. While the public is encouraged to attend; attendance is limited due to Covid-19 restrictions. Municipality-wide Mosquito/Black Fly Control (Proposal)

The Pinette/Flat River and Point Prim Mosquito Programs have prepared a proposal for consideration by the Belfast Community Council. The proposal suggests that the Municipality replicate the highly successful biting fly control program that has been operating in Eastern Kings for many years. The program would be funded by the Municipality, but operated by the Belfast Community Development Corp. It calls for two seasonal employees to take responsibility for the control of mosquito (both salt- and fresh-water species) and black fly larvae throughout the Municipality. Vectobac, which is a completely environmentally safe product for reducing numbers of mosquito and black fly larvae, would be used. The program will require an approximately 3.5% increase in overall property taxes in the region in order to avoid having any impact on other beneficial activities undertaken by the Council. The proposal includes feedback from local tourism operators and real estate agents as to the impact of mosquitoes on their businesses and land values.

On February 16th, 2022, the Rural Municipality of Belfast Council voted to accept a proposal for a, "Municipal-wide Mosquito Abatement Proposal at a cost of \$60,000 for the 2022/2023 fiscal year and ongoing."


