Belfast Consolidated School Report for May 2022

After the first term of grade 10, I always check in with Montague Regional High School to see how our graduates from the year before are doing. Our 11 students passed 43/44 courses, and have an overall average of 84.9%! We have 7/11 of the graduates on the Honour Roll, and 5/11 have an overage over 90+%. For first semester, of the top three placings in grades 10, 11, and 12 overall, Belfast students had three of the nine positions. Scarlett McGeoghegan is first in grade 12, and Emily Fleming is third. In grade 11, Isaac Edward is in third standing. Well done students! It is great to see that together, our school and community have students ready for the challenge of high school. Over the past 12 years, Belfast students have passed their courses at a rate of 97.5% with 60% of the students going on the Honour Roll.

Thanks to our students and staff for helping to fundraise for the Easter Seals Fundraising Drive. Our student leadership team led many different types of events and were able to raise over \$900! Thanks to parents, students, staff, and the community for their support.

Mosquito Control Program

Volunteers have been running this program in the Pinette / Flat River areas for the past 8 years, and it has made a huge difference to the quality of life in this region. There are still plenty of times when the mosquitoes seem bad, but nothing like what it was prior to the introduction of the program. Despite the proposal for a municipality-wide control program being put on hold, the dedicated group of volunteers met on April 21st and voted to continue with the same voluntary program for this upcoming season while more sustainable long-term coordination can be established.

In order to proceed, we need your help. We ask all households in the Pinette/Flat River areas to continue to contribute \$125.00 per household to support the operation of this program. One hundred percent of the funds is used to purchase Vectobac, and for permit and license fees. The easiest way to contribute to the program is by e-mail transfer to: belfastmosquitos@hotmail.com. Alternatively, you could drop off a cheque payable to Pinette/Flat River Mosquito at Cooper's Red & White Food Market.

We also need more volunteers to help with the control program. With more volunteers, we can keep the workload light for everyone. Shoreline Cleanup Activities in May

May is designated as Shoreline Cleanup Month by the PEI Aquaculture Alliance and Bill and Stanley Oyster Company is proud to support this initiative by acting as a local coordinator for the Belfast area.

In 2021, with the support of the Belfast Area Watershed Group and Pisquid River Enhancement Project, we removed almost 2 tonnes of various debris from the shoreline between Wood Islands and Vernon River.

Fees are being waived for anyone wanting to drop off shoreline waste at the IWMC facility in Charlottetown, but we will also be setting up some empty bins at our site in Orwell Cove- 931 Brush Wharf Road for collection of these materials.

Alternatively, we are happy to arrange local pickup or distribution of collection bags with any individuals wanting to contribute to this initiative. Many pickups were made by boat directly from the shoreline last year and with identification of these locations, we can reach areas where vehicle access is difficult.

THE FIRE PREVENTION ACT, states from March to December any year... -"there shall be NO OPEN FIRES (GRASS, BUSH ETC) WITHOUT A PERMIT".

Landowners, contractors, government/private projects are required to have burning permits which are available from the Dept of Energy & Forestry District Office, West Royalty on Beach Grove Road (902-368-4800). It is *IMPERATIVE* that the landowner check the fire index via internet, local radio stations, TV and the newspaper also report the fire index each day through the summer month. If in doubt, contact the Forestry Department.

PLEASE NOTE THE NEW CHANGES LISTED BELOW: FAILURE TO HAVE A VALID BURNING PERMIT WILL RESULT IN AN INVOICE. FOR SERVICES OF \$200.00 OR MORE. HAVE A SAFE SUMMER!

MacPhail Homestead

The Sir Andrew Macphail Homestead will be opening later this spring. The house was built in 1856 and in 1864 Andrew was born into the Macphail family. Andrew's early education was at the Uigg Grammar School followed by Prince of Wales College and McGill University. At McGill he earned an Arts degree and a degree in Medicine. In Montreal he had a medical practice and later became the first professor of Medical History at McGill. From 1905 he spent every summer, except during the war years, at the Homestead in Orwell. When the war came to a close in 1918, Andrew was knighted for his services, in large part due to his developments in military field medicine and considerable literary contribution.

The Homestead displays Macphail artifacts. Plan to make the Homestead a stop on your summer itinerary. Information on programming and hours of operation will soon be available at www.macphailhomestead.ca.


