On August 7<sup>th</sup>, 1803, the ship Polly arrived on the shores of Belfast, Prince Edward Island. This was one of three ships bringing Scottish settlers from the Isle of Skye under the guidance of Thomas Douglas, the 5th Earl of Selkirk. Every year on this date, or close by, now known as "Polly Day", the Belfast Historical Society celebrates the arrival of these settlers and honours their legacy of establishing the community that lives on today. This year, our Polly Day celebration will take place August 6th, from 1:00-3:00pm in front of the Croft House at Lord Selkirk Park. Our very own Alan Buchanan, well known for his love of history, storytelling, and of course humor, will be sharing some tales to enlighten and entertain us. THE FIRE PREVENTION ACT, states from March to December any year... - "there shall be NO OPEN FIRES (GRASS, BUSH ETC) WITHOUT A PERMIT".

Landowners, contractors, government/private projects are required to have burning permits which are available from the Dept of Energy & Forestry District Office, West Royalty on Beach Grove Road (902-368-4800). It is *IMPERATIVE* that the landowner check the fire index via internet, local radio stations, TV and the newspaper also report the fire index each day through the summer month. If in doubt, contact the Forestry Department.

PLEASE NOTE THE NEW CHANGES LISTED BELOW: FAILURE TO HAVE A VALID BURNING PERMIT WILL RESULT IN AN INVOICE, FOR SERVICES OF \$200.00 OR MORE.

The past two golf seasons have been extremely challenging, and we know the countless hours and dedicated efforts that board, members and staff have all put in to make golf one of the most important recreational options available to PE Islanders during the pandemic. Our collective efforts have contributed to a very strong couple of years for everyone at Belfast Highland Greens and the Lord Selkirk Campground.

With this in mind, we wanted to share the latest information on the recent changes to ensure that all of you are aware of the ongoing work that our maintenance crews and staff have and are undertaking to increase your level of enjoyment at **Belfast Highland Greens** and the **Lord Selkirk Campground.** 

Firstly, we want to highlight the excellent work that our maintenance crew are doing at the course. *Derek Gillis* brings incredible knowledge and guidance to all of the crew and certainly takes pride in his work at the course, a joy to work with. *Scott MacLeod*, another seasoned member of the team, handles all of our testing and maintains the course brilliantly. *Dan Martell* and *Evan Stewart* are the younger members of the crew and continue to develop the course and, in particular, have done great work on the bunkers this year among other things. *Lloyd Bruce* and *Gwenda Doyle* have been working hard to ensure the course is in great condition to enhance your golf experience. They are supported by *Colin Singleton* who handles most equipment maintenance and repairs and *William Singleton* who leads all maintenance on the campgrounds and supports the golf maintenance crew. They take pride in their work, and it shows!

In addition, on the Campground side, we have **Dan Sales, Brianna MacDonald, John Langley** and **Theodore MacLeod** who keep the campground, canteen, pool and mini-putt in excellent order. No job is too challenging for our crews and they always have great advice on how to improve the experience for everyone.

Speaking of the Mini-Putt, we want to thank *Matt Kenny* for his work in rebuilding the area to a high standard. A definite welcome addition to the campground and seeing a high level of use this season.

The Pool area has a new improved look which is receiving rave reviews from the swimmers with new stairs in the main pool and next week the stairs in the smaller pool will be replaced allowing us to reopen that pool as well. *William Singleton* did an amazing job on the pool deck and painting all of our buildings and decks on the property. He is currently building a fence around the course focusing on areas that are close to cliffs ensuring safety as a priority for all of us.

The canteen has been upgraded with some new equipment and a fresh coat of paint as well as new floor. The public washrooms on site have all had the floors upgraded and roof re-shingled on one of the bathroom facilities. The stage area is freshly painted as well as the clubhouse – inside and out!

We have purchased new equipment, mowers, rental clubs for men, women and juniors, done countless repairs to everything from rooves, to floors, as well as grounds, greens, tee decks, cart paths, trails, and everything in between. All tolled, an investment of a quarter of a million dollars to the course and campgrounds.

We recently launched 5 new commercials on CBC and social media – be on the lookout for our *Discovering Belfast Ads* which not only highlight **Belfast Highland Greens** and the **Lord Selkirk Campground** but also other local businesses in our beautiful Belfast.

The Clubhouse and Canteen crew are, as always, there to serve you. Under the leadership of our new *Executive Director – Barry Galloway*, the team is doing amazing work. With *Amanda Bell* and *Amy Singleton* our senior team leaders, they support the other clubhouse staff *Kai Boyle, Samantha Campbell*, and *Caleb Creed* in the clubhouse and *Dallas Singleton* and *Alex Jackson* in the Canteen/Pool area. *Lawrence (Larry)* who (although retired) has taken care of the pool for years has been training *Dallas* and *William* in all things pool related and they have taken to it like ducks to water.

In addition to the work on the course and grounds, the board is working hard on a couple of new projects within the community. With a team of local committed volunteers, we are moving toward development of a Wellness Centre for Belfast and also a Housing project for the community. We recently assumed the lease of Pinette Park from the Province and are working with potential investors interested in helping us to further develop the area. We will have more on these projects once we complete the current Golf/Camping season.

We continue to have a unique opportunity ahead of us to grow the game of golf the campground and the community. We appreciate your continued support and look forward to a bright future for Belfast.


