Rural Municipality of Belfast - Council Briefs



Items of note for the Rural Municipality of Belfast (RMB) for the month of August 2023:

Council Lobbies for Reliable 2-Ferry Service

June 27th – Letters to Premier King, MP Lawrence MacAulay, Minister Lantz, Minister Hudson, Minister Deagle, our MLA Darlene Compton, and Northumberland Ferries.

June 27th – Financial Support from Department of Tourism for a ShopBelfastPEI (local purchase program) to help mitigate Ferry closure.

July 19th – Three response letters from the Honourable Premier Dennis King about the Provinces efforts to retain a reliable two-Ferry Service at Wood Islands (see three letters on RMB Website).

July 19th – Members of RMB Council attending emergency Ferry Meeting, hosted by the Eastern PEI Chamber of Commerce.

July 20th **onward**... This lobby effort can not stop! RMB will be on it until there is a satisfactory resolution!

RMB Develops ShopBelfastPEI Local Purchase Program

July 6th – With the Ferry Shut-down at Wood Islands, various members of Council, RMB Administration, and various RMB residents; it was felt that something had to be done immediately to help mitigate the effects of the Ferry closure on RMB local business, residents and tourists to our area.

With the cooperation of the Department of Tourism, *ShopBelfastPEI* was born. A local purchase program that might help to stimulate business to our area. Seems to be helping so far! Check out the program on the RMB Website. Potential to win a \$500.00 prize!

Council Lobbies for Public Transit Service to be extended through RMB area, to Wood Island, to Montague, Return!

July 20th – RMB started the process today to try to convince the Provincial Government to extend the Rural Public Transit Service, to also include a route from Charlottetown, down the Trans Canada Highway to Wood Islands, a stop at the Ferry, on to Montague, and return.

Notice from the Belfast Fire Department

Required rules for burning debris have changed.

Fire season runs from March 15th to November 30th. There are new rules and categories that must be followed. Heavy fines can and will be given.

You can call 1-800-237-5053 to find out about the current burning restrictions in place for the province of PEI. This number can be accessed 24 hours a day; 7 days a week.

For detailed information, please visit our website at princeedwardisland.ca/fireinformation and be aware that there is no burning allowed between 8:00am and 2:00pm. There are 4 categories and a map that details when, and if, burning is allowed.

Out of Province Medical Travel Support Programs

The PEI Government offers financial support for PEI residents travelling to another province for medical services. The Out-of-Province Travel Support Program includes:

Maritime Bus Program

 Islanders requiring out-of-province health care in Nova Scotia or New Brunswick may qualify for fare subsidy to travel with Maritime Bus.

Hope Air - Flights Program

 Since 1988, Prince Edward Island has partnered with Hope Air, a national charity, to provide free flights to PEI residents who cannot afford the cost of a commercial airline ticket for travel to medical services in another province.

Hope Air - Bridge/Ferry Program

 Beginning December 1, 2016, Hope Air, in cooperation with Health PEI, will subsidize the cost of a Confederation Bridge or Northumberland Ferry pass for pre-approved PEI residents (with a valid PEI Health Card) requiring out-of-province transport by private vehicle for medical services in another province.
