- StormSmart your property
 - Put away loose chairs, toys, trampolines (anything that can be a projectile in high winds)
- Are your tanks topped up?
 - Heating Fuel, Propane, Diesel, Gas (anything you use/need especially in a power outage)
- It's not IF the Power goes out It's When!
 - o Is your generator in proper working order?
- Are you stocked up in emergency supplies?
 - Dry Goods, Water, Flashlights
- Checked out the RMB Emergency Plan?

Municipality Preparedness:

 - Providing the Municipality operating guidelines in an emergency
- Establishment of a Warming Centre
 - RMB has made arrangements with the 'Belfast Rec Centre' as its Designated Warming Centre for the RMB area residents in an emergency
 - RMB is finalising a Memorandum of Understanding on how its going to operate
 - The basic operation of the Warming Centre will provide: a Soup Kitchen, a Charging Station, Showers, Warming Centre, and information coordination
- Information Coordination
 - O Utilizing our Website, our Facebook Page, our Council and Municipal Phone Network, Emergency Support Links, and radio medias; and other more delayed systems like the Belfast Newsletter, Newspapers, etc. to send out timely, important messaging.

It is hard to imagine that we are once more turning our calendar page to September...a month of new beginnings for many.

Our Scottish Heritage/Cultural Centre (Croft House) will be open, and we invite friends and visitors to drop in, experience our history, check out Rick Barton's amazing display of artifacts, browse our wee Scottish gift shop, along with a variety of books and genealogical records.

Save the Date of September 28th at 7:00pm as we are ready to host our first regular meeting in 2023. More information will be available closer to the actual date, but we have some strawberries and ice cream as part of our celebration as the weather was not kind to us on August 5th. We also have some other reasons to celebrate as we strive to "Keep History Alive" in Belfast!

Belfast and Area Watershed Group (BAWG)

Did you know that BAWG has been conducting Bank Swallow surveys for the past 5 years? This year, we've become part of the working group for the Atlantic Canada Bank Swallow Monitoring Program. This means all our data will now get shared with NatureCounts, a national database run by Birds Canada. These small birds are an at-risk species due to population declines. This summer we've surveyed 70km's of shoreline and found 834 burrows and 6 new colonies!

Mark your calendars! BAWG will be hosting an Information Presentation with the Sustainable Forest Alliance on October 12th at the Wood Islands Market – 7:00pm. This session will present a model forest management that is ecologically sustainable, climate-smart, and economically viable. All are welcome.

Notice from the Belfast Fire Department
